



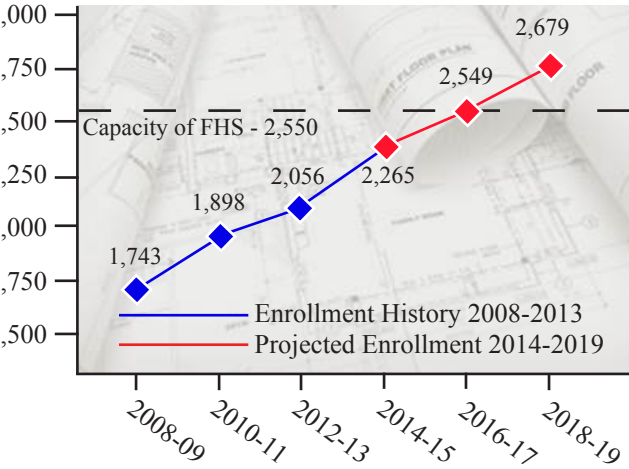
FRENSHIP ISD - 2014 BOND

Since 2001, Frenship ISD has witnessed an enrollment growth of more than 3,000 students. With the support of the local community, FISD has opened four new campuses since 2006. Three of the campuses - Oak Ridge Elementary, Heritage Middle School, and the district's seventh elementary campus opening in 2014 - were part of a \$128 million bond passed in 2007.

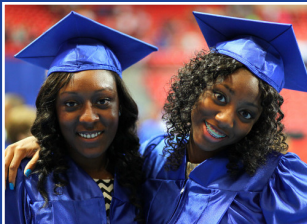
Demographic studies and projections show enrollment growth within FISD is expected to continue in the district's near future.

This enrollment growth continues to make its way to Frenship High School, where the campus has an enrollment capacity of 2,550 students:

ELEMENTARY CAMPUS (8TH ELEMENTARY IN FISD)

The pace of residential construction within the district boundaries is pushing elementary campus enrollments to their building capacities of 750 students. An eighth elementary campus in Frenship ISD would help the district manage elementary enrollment capacity concerns.

FRENSHIP HIGH SCHOOL NINTH GRADE CENTER

Demographic studies show that the capacity of the current Frenship High School campus is 2,550. While current enrollment numbers at the Frenship High School are 2,120, enrollment numbers in the fifth grade through eighth grade classes are 2,596, a total that will surpass the capacity of FHS when these students reach high school in August 2017. These enrollment numbers do not factor in potential district enrollment growth in the near future. A Ninth Grade Center would be constructed with a beginning capacity of 1,000 students.

This design would alleviate capacity concerns at FHS. The Ninth Grade Center configuration was created to give Frenship citizens, future Frenship ISD Board of Trustees, and future FISD administrations flexibility to expand the Ninth Grade Center to house both ninth and tenth grade students at this campus should they desire to do so.



TECHNOLOGY AND SECURITY UPGRADES

Upgrades in FISD's technology and security are designed to enhance the students' educational experience while providing a safer environment. Security upgrades include keyless entry systems on all doors as well as equipment to enhance the communication efforts to both internal and external audiences. Technology upgrades include the addition of collaborative learning classrooms where students can engage with education in a technology-driven environment.
